The Covanta Alexandria/Arlington Resource Recovery Facility began commercial operation in February 1988 and serves about 300,000 residents of the County of Arlington and the City of Alexandria, which jointly own the site. The facility's three, 325 ton-per-day furnaces process 975 tons of solid waste, generating up to 23 megawatts of renewable energy that is sold to Dominion Virginia Power Company. The facility is located on the smallest site of any of the Energy-from-Waste facilities operated by Covanta. We will have an extended Q&A time before touring the facility.

The facility is not suitable for wheelchairs, and flat footwear, long pants and long sleeve tops are required. Arrive 15 minutes before time to sign a visitor agreement. A waitlist will be maintained and all registrants will be contacted by the event coordinator via phone or email at least one week prior to the event.
