Join Encore Learning for a guided tour of one of the oldest and loveliest of the mansions built in the early 1900s along Massachusetts Avenue. Anderson House is the Headquarters for the 230 year old Society of the Cincinnati –America’s oldest patriotic fraternal society. This Beaux –Arts city home of Larz and Isabel Anderson is a gem to behold and contains a fascinating museum relating to the American Revolution, as well as housing the Anderson’s private collection of international art and furnishings

Participants should arrive by 1:20 pm and wait inside the museum’s entry hall to meet their guide. The tour lasts approximately 1 hour. Participants may wish to organize lunch before hand at one of the many restaurants in and around Dupont Circle or on P Street, behind the museum. A wait list will be maintained and all registrants will be contacted by the event coordinator via phone or email at least 1 week prior to the event.

The Society of the Cincinnati at Anderson House is located at 2118 Massachusetts Ave. NW, Washington DC 20008, two blocks west of the Dupont Circle Metro stop on the Red Line. There is limited metered street parking in the area. Metro busses go down Massachusetts Ave from Wisconsin Ave. and there is a bus from Georgetown area (on Q Street) that goes down P street, which is just behind the museum (get off at the 21st St bus stop and walk north to Massachusetts Ave.).
