"A Boyar Wedding Feast", the centerpiece of Hillwood's exhibition focusing on the work of painter, Konstantin Makovsky (1839-1915), brings to life the exotic ambience of late 19th-century Russia. The intricate details of the painting are enhanced by embroidered garments, pearl headdresses, and gleaming silver, enamel, and ivory from Hillwood's collection, together with loaned items from the Metropolitan Museum, the Walters, and other collections.
