Yayoi Kusama: Infinity Mirrors exhibition is a celebration of the legendary Japanese artist's 65-year career and promises to be 2017's essential art experience. Enjoy an unprecedented chance to discover six of Kusama's dazzling mirror rooms at once, alongside whimsical installations, vibrant sculpture and colorful, large-scale paintings making their U.S. debut. Because of the expected popularity of this exhibition, our tour will begin an hour before the museum opens; people not on a tour will need to get free timed passes in advance to see the kaleidoscopic environments that offer a chance to step into an illusion of infinite space.

Be sure to arrive on time. We will assemble in the lobby of the museum. The doors open early at 9AM for tour groups only. Our contact person at the museum is Ashley Meadows. Although this is one of the largest special events ever, a waitlist will be maintained and all waitlist members who get into the tour will be contacted via phone or email at least one week prior to the event.
