Pnina Agenyahu is the Senior Shlicha (Emissary) of the Jewish Agency at the Jewish Federation of Greater Washington. She served as Director of the Hillel Center at Tel Aviv University where she created a pluralistic space for Tel Aviv U students to explore their Jewish identity. Pnina holds a BA from Hebrew university in Jewish History and sociology and MA in political and public leadership from Tel Aviv University.

Dana Kalishov, a JCCNV Emissary, is a seventh-generation Israeli on her mother's side, and fourth-generation on her father's. While serving in the army, Dana was a military education officer at two different units, and a Cadet Education Officer at the Naval Academy. Dana earned her Bachelor's degree in Sociology/Anthropology and Management from Ben Gurion University.
