Although Piero di Cosimo worked in the shadow of great artists of the 15th-century, he was esteemed as a creative spirit of uncommon imagination: His fantastic inventions transformed the verses of ancient poets and devout religious themes into fanciful myths and mysterious allegories, the meanings of which continue to entice us today. Join Encore Learning on a tour of 44 of this artist's works that illustrate his use of a strange visual language in paintings that include large altarpieces intended to adorn the churches of his native Florence.
