Irving Penn (1917-2009), known for his iconic fashion, portrait, and still life images, ranks among the foremost photographers of the 20th Century. Join Encore Learning on a tour of a retrospective celebrating his legacy as a modern master through photographs from all stages of his career. On display are 146 photographs from the museum's permanent collection. The exhibition presents several previously unseen or never exhibited photographs. Also on view for the first time are Super 8 mm films of Penn in Morocco, made by his wife Lisa Fonssagrives-Penn, that add a vivid picture of the artist at work.
