**Looking at Asia from  
Washington and Beijing:  
Two Very Different Pictures**

Living in Washington and reading American media, many of us have an understanding of Asia, and we sometimes wonder why Beijing takes actions that we consider disruptive. Asia looks like a very different place if you live in Beijing and read Chinese media. That very different view may lead Beijing to see our actions as disruptive. What's the difference? Does it Matter?

**Dr. David Keegan** holds a PhD in Chinese history from the University of California, Berkeley, and is an Encore Learning instructor. He was a US Foreign Service officer for 30 years serving in Korea, China, Taiwan, Singapore and New Zealand. He was deputy director of the American Institute in Taiwan and deputy chief of mission and chargé at the US Embassy in New Zealand. He also served as director in the office of Taiwan policy, the office of regional affairs for South and Central Asia and the office of strategic, proliferation and military affairs in the State Department bureau of intelligence and research.
