Immerse yourself in the sights, smells, and sounds of the season in the Botanic Garden's annual holiday show, Season's Greenings, celebrating the 100th anniversary of the National Park Service and the 50th anniversary of the National Historic Preservation Act. Displays include a model train winding its way through plant-based re-creations of iconic national parks and historic places. See the Grand Canyon, Old Faithful Inn, the Gateway Arch, Mount Vernon, the Statue of Liberty, plus the Garden's collection of D.C. landmarks, all made from natural materials.

The U.S. Botanic Garden is located at 100 Maryland Ave. SW. Washington D.C. 20001. The nearest Metro station is Federal Center, SW on the Orange and Silver lines (3rd and D Streets, SW). It is a five-minute walk north on 3rd St. to Maryland Ave. There is very limited metered street parking around the Garden.
