Enjoy an In-depth Cathedral Highlights Tour followed by a Traditional English tea with sandwiches, scones, and scenic views of Washington from the Cathedral's seventh floor Pilgrim Observation Gallery. This docent-led tour of the world's sixth largest cathedral explores the Cathedral's Neo-Gothic Architecture, and shares the story of its 90 year construction. See the cathedral's glorious stained glass windows and hear the fascinating stories behind the statuary of famous Americans found within this space.

Carpooling is recommended. A waitlist will be maintained and all registrants will be contacted by the event coordinator via phone or email at least one week prior to the event.

The Cathedral is located at the corner of Massachusetts and Wisconsin Avenues in Northwest Washington, D.C.,—3101 Wisconsin Avenue, NW. We recommend parking in the Cathedral's underground parking garage.

There is very limited parking on the Cathedral grounds and in the surrounding neighborhood. Underground Parking Garage Entrance: Enter via Wisconsin Avenue, at the traffic signal just south of Woodley Road. Garage Hours: 6 am to 11 pm. Handicap parking spaces: located on each level of the garage near the elevators.
